Please Note: Comprehensive financial information is given at first consultation.

Treatment prices include the following: HFEA registration fee, outpatient monitoring and theatre fees, local anaesthesia (PCB), laboratory fees including freezing and storage of suitable surplus embryos, pregnancy test and pregnancy scan, follow-up consultation within two months of a failed treatment. The pre-treatment consultation and work-up fees, and the drugs required for the treatment, are not included in the treatment fee.

Egg Share Programme: Egg share providers are not charged anything for the IVF or IVF/ICSI treatment itself. However, egg share providers are required to pay for all preparation for their own treatment, ie. for consultation, semen assessment, viral screening, hormone profile and any scans to assess either their potential for producing eggs or for assessing the quality of the lining of the womb (the endometrium). If all these tests are carried out at Bourn Hall, the maximum cost will be £650, but if the screening tests are done elsewhere, and acceptable in-date reports available, this fee can be reduced.

PAYMENT

Consultation and pre-treatment screening tests: payable on the day they occur.

Treatment costs: payment in full by debit or credit card, or bank transfer. Payment must be received on or before the first visit during the treatment cycle. We accept the following methods of payment:

¹ The cost of storage of eggs, sperm and embryos for the first year is included in the treatment package price and they will be stored for the period you select on the HFEA consent forms relating to your treatment.

² We will send you an Annual Consent Form to confirm your wish to continue storage, or arrange disposal or donation. If you wish to continue storage, you will be charged the annual storage fee at the start of the second and subsequent storage years, for each year or part thereof.

³ The costs of local anaesthesia (paracervical block) or sedation is included in the package price. There is an additional charge for general anaesthesia.

*All assisted conception treatment cycles are required to be registered with the Human Fertilisation & Embryology Authority (HFEA). This fee is collected by clinics and passed on to the HFEA. The HFEA registration fee becomes due at the start of a treatment cycle.

EGG SHARE PROGRAMME (providers)

To optimise your chance of becoming pregnant as an egg share provider, you will require pre-treatment assessment as for standard IVF. The fee of £650 for pre-treatment assessment can be reduced if the relevant results can be provided from a different source. Your treatment, including drugs and ICSI if required, is free of charge. Pre-treatment assessment for second and subsequent attempts is also free of charge.

TREATMENT WITH DONOR SPERM

Recent changes in the regulations to give stricter control of the number of births per donor (maximum of 10 families) have necessitated a new approach to the allocation of donor sperm. Our approach to this issue assures you of a total of five ampoules of sperm being reserved for you from your chosen donor. The fee for your sperm reservation is refundable if a live birth is not achieved or you decide to stop treatment and you have no frozen embryos from that donor. The sperm reservation fee is additional to the cost of treatment. Often in the past a donors' availability was cancelled at short notice and treatment delayed as a result, this has been further complicated by the regulation requiring frozen embryos (potential live births) to be included in the estimation of the number of families a donor has achieved.

WHAT IF I DON'T COMPLETE TREATMENT?

Unfortunately it is sometimes necessary to discontinue treatment for medical reasons. Here are the most common examples of our discount rates.

IVF cycle

If an IVF cycle is discontinued for medical reasons before any eggs are collected, we will refund you the full cost of the IVF Treatment Package. Once eggs are collected then no refund will be made. We do not refund any of the costs relating to the pre-treatment procedures or drugs.

Frozen embryo transfer (FET) cycle

If an FET cycle is discontinued for medical reasons before thawing, we will refund you the full cost of the FET Treatment Package. If embryos fail to thaw or cleave, there will be a 50% refund of the Treatment Package fee. We do not refund any of the costs relating to the pre-treatment procedures or drugs.

IUI

In the event that insemination does not take place we will refund you the full cost of the IUI Treatment Package. We do not refund any of costs relating to the pre-treatment procedures or drugs.

Donor sperm

If your treatment using donor sperm is unsuccessful, either after IUI or after all frozen embryos created from the use of donor sperm are used, the 'sperm reservation' charge will be refunded.

Egg freezing

Stage 1 includes down regulation, stimulation, monitoring, egg collection and egg freezing. If eggs are collected, but none are successfully frozen, we will refund the full Stage 1 cost.

Stage 2 includes thawing, ICSI, early embryo development and day 2 or 3 embryo transfer. If there is no embryo transfer, the full Stage 2 cost will be refunded.

OTHER PROCEDURES

Blastocyst (extended) culture: In the event that the blastocyst (extended) culture fails prior to the transfer of the embryos we will refund you £800, the full cost of the culture procedure.

Freeze all embryos: If your IVF treatment is halted for medical reasons prior to transfer of your embryos, necessitating the freezing of the embryos created in the treatment cycle, the cost of the first frozen embryo transfer will be reduced by 50%.

Embryo donation: If your treatment with donated embryos is discontinued for medical reasons, or if the embryos fail to thaw or cleave, the Treatment Package fee will be refunded in full. We do not refund any of the costs relating to the pre-treatment procedures or drugs.

HOW AND WHEN DO I HAVE TO PAY?

Payment in full must be received on or before the first day of the treatment cycle. Treatment cannot be continued if payment is not received. A general guide to payments is shown below –

Terms & Conditions of Treatment at Bourn Hall Clinic
(Version 4 valid from May 2011)

Place and Time of Payment

- 1 Payment must be received by Bourn Hall on or before the first day of any treatment cycle. Payment should be in sterling and by way of Visa / Mastercard or American Express credit/debit card, bank draft or bank transfer.

Place of Treatment

- 2 Unless otherwise agreed between the parties, treatment shall take place at Bourn Hall. Bourn Hall will not give advice, assistance or treatment outside the United Kingdom except by prior agreement.
- 3 Where patients attend Bourn Hall having begun treatment, or taken advice elsewhere, Bourn Hall accepts no liability whatsoever for the consequences of that treatment or advice and gives no warranty that such treatment or advice was properly given.

Duration

- 4 The Terms & Conditions shall apply for so long as the patient(s) are undertaking any treatment which is recommended by and directly under the supervision of the staff of Bourn Hall.

Jurisdiction

- 5 The proper law for the construction of this agreement is the law of England and Wales and the parties hereby irrevocably agree that all disputes, claims, complaints, issues and proceedings arising out of treatment, assistance and advice given at or by Bourn Hall shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales.

The Parties hereby agree that all claims for injury, loss or damage connected with or arising out of the advice, assistance and/or treatment given at or by Bourn Hall shall be subject to the laws of England and Wales and the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales, howsoever that injury, loss or damage shall be said to have been caused and whatsoever the cause of action raised.

Frustration

- 6 In the event that it shall be impossible or unlawful to embark on, continue or complete an agreed course of treatment or provide a service substantially the same as that agreed, neither party shall, after the event giving rise to the impossibility or illegality of performance, be liable for further performance of the agreement, always provided that the impossibility or illegality does not result from a breach of the terms of this agreement by either party.

Withdrawal

- 7 In the event that the patient shall unreasonably refuse to accept or follow advice given by any employee or agent of Bourn Hall, either party may withdraw from the terms of the agreement to provide advice, assistance and treatment and treat itself as discharged from its terms, provided always that the withdrawal be communicated in writing and that reasons for that withdrawal be given.

Definitions

"Bourn Hall" shall mean Bourn Hall Limited

"the patient(s)" shall mean the person or couple seeking advice, assistance and/or treatment from Bourn Hall.

"Advice, assistance and/or treatment" shall have the meaning necessary for their context and shall be defined by reference to the services from time to time offered by Bourn Hall.
